



Minimalism, urban abstraction, and solitude guide this visual journey.




Shadow of a Bell Tower

The bell tower leans, the dome rises, and time wavers in a veil of forgetfulness.




Silhouette of San Giorgio

The island and its iconic church seen from the opposite shore.




Mist over the City – Imaginary Venice A peaceful walk along the Giudecca Canal.

St. Mark's Basilica emerges through layers of distortion — a ghostly echo of Venice, suspended in digital silence.




The Bridge Without Passage

A bridge left to itself.




Fall of Light $\,$ - $\,$ A gleam brushing the damp ground.
